Review of 2013:

President's Report - Winton

In 2013 we ran 6 Competitive Events, 5 Coaching Days, and 2 Family Fun Rides. Over 250 Riders attended these events. There were 50-70 volunteers at each competitive event. Four Classes qualified for the Club Championship. There were only a few injuries over the season.

Coaching Co-ordinator- Nathan

5 Coaching Days. 13 Coaches for Kickstart Coaching. 2 Sweep Rider Training Days. 30 Parents attended the sweep training. 2 Family Fun Weekends. Apart from Kickstart all coaching days and family funs were held at West Talbot property.

Treasurer's Report - Sarah

See attached summary. Most profitable event Kickstart Coaching. Least profitable Small Group Coaching and Family Fun Rides. January opening balance \$18,788 closing balance \$44,975.

Equipment Co-ordinator – Gary

At the start of 2013 the Club had approx. \$25K worth of equipment. \$5,000 worth of equipment donated during 2013.

We also purchased a new quad during the year after fundraising. We have just purchased a 3rd quad. The Club now has lots of equipment that needs to be looked after. Bought and sold tractor because it was too hard to operate and not as useful as the quad. The Club has just purchased a car trailer to carry the quad bikes.

Volunteer Co-ordinator- Sue

We had a good response when people were asked to help. Only about 20 families that regularly don't help out (out of 250 families that attend). We had over 200 people help at events through 2013.
